Our GlaceEMR version 6.0 software recently achieved ONC-ACB Electronic Health Records (EHR) certification via Drummond Group, LLC. The certification will enable our clients to meet the requirements necessary for Merit Based Incentive Payments System (MIPS) eligibility, which incorporates many of the requirements from the Medicare/Medicaid EHR Incentive Program (i.e. Meaningful Use program).

This certification enables our team to better serve clients preparing for future requirements and empowers us to sustain relevant software which will meet practice needs. To earn the certification, our software was successfully tested to be in accordance with applicable standards and criteria outline by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).

For Glenwood Systems customers seeking to meet requirements for the 2018 MIPS program, they may use the prior certified 2014 Edition GlaceEMR version 5.0 or the certified 2015 Edition GlaceEMR version 6.0. Customers seeking to meet the program requirements for 2019 and 2020 must adapt to GlaceEMR version 6.0 to remain within the program's requirements.

Glenwood Systems was recently added to the Carequality Interoperability Framework, a health data sharing initiative aimed at increasing transparency and collaboration among healthcare providers. The framework enables exchange among healthcare providers, through existing networks. Our clients may join the framework by submitting a Carequality Interoperability Framework addendum with Glenwood Systems.
